	A. <u>By Destroying and Annulling Satan's Power of Death Over Mankind.</u>	
	1. The death on the cross did this.	Heb 2:14; Jn 19:30
	2. Before Christ died on the cross, all souls went into the lower parts of the earth, either into hell (torment) or paradise. None entered into salvation or the kingdom of heaven.	Heb 2:15
	3. Jesus came to deliver the saints. This is why he began to preach, and to say, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."	Heb 2:16; Mt 4:17; Eph 4:8-13
	B. <u>That He Might Be A Merciful and Faithful High Priest in Things Pertaining To God.</u>	Heb 2:17
	1. Make reconciliation for the sins of the people.	
	2. We are to understand that even though he has passed into heaven, he can still be touched with the feeling of our infirmities.	
	3. We should come freely to the throne of Grace in prayer to find help in time of need. This is any time we seem to let go of the confidence and rejoicing.	Heb 2:16; Heb 3:6; Heb 4:14; Heb 7:24-25
	4. The saints are heirs of salvation. They must keep that hope firm unto the end.	Heb 1:14; Heb 3:6; Heb 2:10; Heb 5:7-9

- A. His Sufferings Were In The Days of His Flesh On Earth.
1. He prayed with strong crying and tears to God. Heb 2:7
 2. He prayed to be saved from death by satanic powers who tried to kill him in the garden before he could get to the cross. Mt 26:39; Lu 22:43-49
Mk 14:33; I Pet 4:12-16
 3. Jesus began to be sore amazed. Heb 2:10
- B. He Became Perfect (Immortal Again) Heb 5:9
1. He became the author (source) of eternal salvation. Heb 5:6; Heb 7:24
 2. He became a high priest forever.
- VI. Why The Salvation Is So Great. Heb. 2:3
- A. Because All Sons Who Are Brought Into Glory Will Reign In The World To Come. It Is The Kingdom of The Messiah. Heb 2:5; Rev. 22:5;
II Tim. 2:12
